- Plans, organizes and implements specific treatment programs for individual patients with pelvic floor dysfunctions including chronic pelvic pain, myofascial pain syndrome, and bowel and bladder.
- Our pelvic floor therapist will be responsible for treating women and men with a variety of diagnoses including some oncology related diagnoses. The pelvic floor therapist would be working closely with urologists, OBGYN, colorectal, and GI MD's.
- Caseload may include general orthopedic, sports medicine, post-surgical, work comp, balance & fall risk patients (Dependent upon pelvic health patient volume).
